They scored **211 in 15**

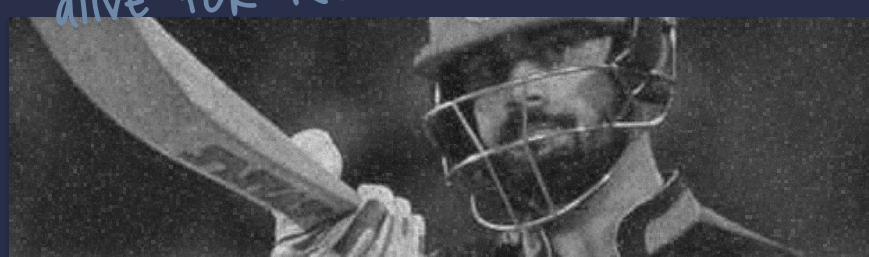
The man? **100 of 47.**
